FROM POPE FRANCIS CHAPTER FIVE

Paths of vouth

What does it mean to live the years of our youth in the transforming light of the Gospel? We need to raise this question, because youth, more than a source of pride, is a gift of God: "To be young is a grace, a blessing".

It is a gift that we can squander meaninglessly, or receive with gratitude and live to the full.

God is the giver of youth and he is at work in the life of each young person. Youth is a blessed time for the young and a grace for the Church and for the world. It is joy, a song of hope and a blessing. Making the most of our youthful years entails seeing this season of life as worthwhile in itself, and not simply as a brief prelude to adulthood.

A time of dreams and decisions

In Jesus' day, the passage from childhood was a significant step in life, one joyfully celebrated. When Jesus restored life to a man's daughter, he first called her a "child" (Mk 5:39), but then addressed her as a "young girl" (Mk 5:41). By saying to her: "Young girl, get up (talitha cum)", he made her more responsible for her life, opening before her the door to youth.

"Youth, as a phase in the development of the personality, is marked by dreams which gather momentum, by relationships which acquire more and more consistency and balance, by trials and experiments, and by choices which gradually build a life project. At this stage in life, the young are called to move forward without cutting themselves off from their roots, to build autonomy but not in solitude".

{Pope Francis, apostolic exhortation, CHRISTUS VIVIT —to the young people and the entire people of God]

FROM FR. HENRY DUC

In my first appointment as assistant priest in a parish in the diocese, there was a lot to be done and learned as a newly ordained, and some of those were completely unexpected.

I remember one quiet Saturday afternoon, while I was doing the work in my office upstairs, and I heard the parish priest raised his voice downstairs, like he was engaged in the argument with someone. That was strange to me, since I thought that there should be no one else in the presbytery then except the two of us.

Out of curiosity, I ran down and couldn't believe what I was seeing: my parish priest, a tall man was holding a smaller fellow, whom he claimed that he found him hiding behind the door of the laundry next to his bedroom. The intruder just managed to sneak in and it was unfortunate for him, the master made his sudden return from a short trip around the place, and caught him on the hope.

As for me, I had no idea of the presence of such an unwanted

guest downstairs, who could put us into lot of troubles, if the parish priest didn't come back on time to catch him. After giving him a good dressing down, the theft was allowed to go, of course with the threat, that it won't be the same for him next time, if he dares to do the same again. In the context of theft and unwanted guest, we start both a new liturgical year and the season of Advent with a Gospel dealing with the burglar character. Here we have Jesus utilizing the imagery of the burglar to convey his message about the nature of his coming, that it will definitely entail the element of surprise, just like a break-in of a burglar in the middle of the night, which no one has no idea when he would

strike. So, the best line of defense is to stay awake and up to

make sure that he can't get in, no matter what. It is worth to remember the significance of Advent, which originates from the Latin ADVENTUS meaning coming, the four-week season prior to Christmas. This is a special time aims to help prepare ourselves not just for the commemoration of the birth of Jesus, but also the twofold coming of Christ at the end of time and at the time of our death, which is beyond our expectation.

Let us pray that all that we do and say in our everyday lives will serve us well as preparatory steps for the time of the Lord. Pray that we won't be caught badly unprepared when he knocks on our door.

Have a heavenly-oriented week.
